Admission to BMA is very inclusive and open to all Abbotsford students – there is no audition process. We have children who are new to Canada and many who are Canadian by birth but representative of a wide variety of cultures.

Based on the revolutionary El Sistema (the System) program in Venezuela, the goal of Bakerview Music Academy is to inspire Abbotsford youth to achieve their full potential and to have a positive impact on their lives and society as a whole. Our program fosters better citizens while developing talented musicians who get to experience the joy of performing.

We're looking for a SEA who values equity and diversity as our program offers professional music lessons to children from diverse backgrounds who have varied abilities.

In this position, you will:

- Report to the Program Director
- Provide student support as required to assist music teacher-artists with classroom management
- Provide support to students with respect to their diverse learning needs and/or social and emotional challenges
- Manage verbal and/or physical "acting out" behaviour in positive ways
- Supervise students, as required, and help teacher-artists and the program director deal with disciplinary problems as they occur
- Discuss with team members any changes which may be made to an individual student's program to better support their learning
- Support parent engagement by assisting with signing in and signing out students and helping at BMA family events/recitals
- Perform other work within the SEA role as required
